Meeting was called to order at 1:35 p.m. by President: Nancy Casteel.

Carol Anwar introduced today's speaker:

- Carolyn Walters spoke on a very important topic: Women's Health Issues to maintain your health as long as possible.
- Practice of women's wellness to include acne, PCOS, and yearly physicals.
- PCOS: high percentage of these women has type II diabetes. Reason: they don't make enough estrogen monthly.
- No progesterone, no ovulation.
- Takes two cups of estrogen to rupture or ovulate.
- Estrogen is offset by progesterone (checks and balance).
- Put patients on the pill to get enough progesterone and estrogen.
- Different estrogen in birth control pills –vs- HRT.
- Different types of breast cancer: estrogen or progesterin receptor site.
- Birth control pills work in women with androgen problems because we need progesterone everyday.
- Birth control pills protect from ovarian cancer by 40% to 80%.
- Keep women on B.C. pills until menopause.
- Horses do not get breast cancer.
- Humans are the only mammals alive after child bearing years.
- Put clients on HRT about age 52.
- No HRT check cholesterol and bone density.
- Pre-menopausal = B.C. pills. Post Menopausal = HRT until death.
- Pap smears saves women from dying of cervical cancer. Do yearly.
- Viral cervical cancer is a STD.

- HPV is found in 97% of women under age of 40. Once you have HPV it is always there in the body and can be activated by stress, smoking, and other viruses.
- Generic drugs only need to by 60% of the original formula. Generics have risks.
- Every woman needs to be measured once a year for bone density.
- Stop drinking juices and soda pop to get rid of type II diabetes. Drink juice with protein to slow absorption i.e. Cookies with milk, bread and butter
- Estrogen makes insulin more readily available to cells.
- Gain less weight on HRT.
- Estrogen is the #1 drug studied for over 60 years.
- Breast cancer is curable. Do your yearly mammograms.
- Communication tips: nurses are better being nurturing than Doctors.
- Recommends reading "The Alphabet –vs- the Goddess" book.
- Estrogen and brain functions: do PET scan of brain. Shows similar pattern of women's hot flashes and Alzheimer's disease.
- HRT clients on estrogen have less severe Alzheimer's disorders.
- Alzheimer's is more dominate in women.
- Estrogen in males comes from the brain: hypothalamus.
- Women's estrogen comes from the ovaries.
- Depression and anxiety is also treated at clinic.
- Depression is due to lack of neurotransmitters. Drugs commonly used are Flexor XL and Wellbutrin SR which are both women friendly.
